New Interactive Videos at Permanent Exhibit "Dr. Kitanomaru's Bio Pharmaceutical Laboratory" at the Science Museum

July 28, 2010 (Tokyo) - Since July 2006, Chugai Pharmaceutical Co., Ltd. Since the start of the exhibit in July 2006, the number of views has exceeded 170,000. Positive comments have been given from viewers, mainly elementary and junior high school students, including "Science is exciting!" and "Biological drugs are wonderful!"
